Fishing Came

GoGo tried to grab her shoe out of the water but would have been better off fishing for it. Create this fishing game to fish for shoes.

YOU WILL NEED

- Dowel rod (about 20cms long)
- Strong string or thin rope
- Small magnet (a round or bar magnet will work)
- Paper clips
- The shoes printed onto cardboard
- Scissors
- Glue or tape

PREPARE THE FISHING ROD:

- Tie one end of the string to the end of the dowel rod. The length of the string will depend on how long you want the fishing line to be.
- Attach the magnet to the other end of the string. You can tie the string directly around the magnet if it's a bar magnet, or use tape or glue to secure it if it's a round magnet. Ensure the magnet is securely attached to prevent any accidents during play.

MAKE THE SHOES:

- Have children cut out the shoes.
- Attach a paper clip to each shoe

SET UP THE GAME:

- Spread the shoes out on the floor, a table, or another flat surface. If playing outside, you might want to place them on a blanket to keep them clean.
- Each player takes turns using the fishing rod to try and catch the shoe by
 connecting the magnet to the paper clips

GAME VARIATIONS:

- Add point values to each shoe and keep score to see who can catch the most points. The sparkly shoes could be worth a lot more than the others.
- Write simple math problems or words on the fish for educational play, where players must solve a problem or read the shoes correctly to keep their catch.
