



SEED BOMBS

Plant native flowers in your garden to attract native bees.

YOU WILL NEED:

- ✿ Wildflower seeds - from your garden or a garden shop. It is very important that native seeds are used rather than potential weed seeds.
- ✿ Clay powder from craft shops or clay soil if available.
- ✿ Peat-free compost
- ✿ Water
- ✿ A bowl

INSTRUCTIONS:

- ✿ Mix 1 cup of seeds with 5 cups of compost and 2-3 cups of clay powder or clay soil in a bowl.
- ✿ Slowly mix in water with your hands until everything sticks together.
- ✿ Roll the mixture into firm balls.
- ✿ Leave the balls to dry in a sunny spot.
- ✿ Now for the fun bit - Plant your seed bombs by throwing them at bare parts of the garden or on urban wasteland (neglected roundabouts, flower beds and planters etc.) and come back in a couple of weeks to see what pops up!
