



Bird Feeder

While you may not live in an area with swallows, all native birds need our help to help them thrive against introduced species. Use the instructions below to make a native bird seed feeder.

YOU WILL NEED

- A finished toilet roll or cardboard tube
- A plate
- Native bird seed
- A pop stick or butter knife
- Peanut butter, vegetable shortening or animal fat / lard
- String, hemp twine or wool

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Use the pop stick or knife to cover the cardboard tube in peanut butter or shortening.
- 2 Pour the bird seed onto the plate.
- 3 Roll the cardboard tube in the bird seed and pat on extra seed to ensure it is completely covered and well stuck.
- 4 Thread string, twine or wool through the tube and tie to hang the feeder from a branch or simply slide the tube over the end of a branch.
- 5 Watch to see which birds are attracted to your bird feeder.
