

ANZAC BISCUITS - BAG AND TAG

Use the instructions below to make a gift bag and tag for the biscuits. The cellophane window is optional depending on child dexterity. For the tags you will need thick coloured card and wavy scissors.

BAG AND TAG ACTIVITY

Materials

- The attached template enlarged onto coloured A3 paper
- Scissors
- Double sided sticky tape
- Cellophane
- Hole punch
- Ribbon
- Two different coloured pieces of cardboard at least 7cm x 7cm
- PVA glue



Method

1. Cut out the bag template and the oval.
2. Cut a rectangle of cellophane larger than the oval hole.
3. Using double sided tape stick the cellophane over the oval hole.
4. Using PVA glue the tabs to form the bag.
5. Cut a 5cm x 4cm rectangle (A) and a 7cm x 6cm rectangle (B) from the card (B). Glue A onto B.
6. Punch two holes in the top of the bag and a single hole in the gift tag and thread ribbon through the bag and gift tag and tie securely.
7. Present your bag as a home made gift to show you care about some one as much as the women of Australia cared about their war heroes.
