

WOODEN PLANE

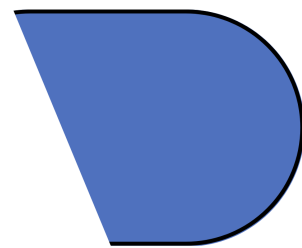
While this inspiring true story is about a young Australian hero who proved that anything is possible if you believe in yourself and follow your dreams it is also about flying. Use the instructions below to make a wooden peg plane you can fly around outside.

YOU WILL NEED

- Wooden peg
- 3 coloured popsicle sticks
- Scissors
- Glue
- Paint and paintbrush

METHOD

- 1 Paint the wooden peg.
- 2 Glue one popsicle stick to the top of the peg, near the end that opens.
- 3 Glue another popsicle stick to the other side of the peg, directly underneath the first - making the front of the bi-plane.
- 4 Cut about a third off the end of the remaining popsicle sticks.
- 5 Cut the tip off the smaller piece, making a diagonal cut at one end and leaving the rounded tip at the other.
- 6 Glue the larger piece of cut popsicle stick to the end of the peg away from the first 2 sticks (the rear of the plane).
- 7 Glue the small piece leftover to the middle of the rear stick with the diagonal side against the stick on the peg.
- 8 Leave to dry before flying around outside.
