2017	The Uluru Statement From The Heart is released.
2013	Nova Peris is the first female Aboriginal senator in Federal Parliament.
1992	The Mabo decision recognises that the land was never ceded but taken by force.
1971	The Aboriginal flag is created.
1910-1970	The stolen generation are taken from their families.
1896	The remaining 10% of aboriginal people are allowed to vote.
1770	Captain James Cook declares Australia "terra nullius".
2023	A referendum is held to decide if Australia should have a First Nations voice in parliament.
2016	Linda Burney is the first female Aboriginal to sit in the House of Representatives.
2008	Prime Minister Rudd apologises to the First Nations people.
1971	Neville Bonner becomes the first Aboriginal senator in Federal Parliament.
1967	Aboriginal people are counted as Australians in the referendum.
1901	The Australian Federation is formed.
1778	The first fleet arrived and there were 750,000 Aboriginal people living in Australia.
1606	The earliest record of contact between Europeans and Aboriginal people.
