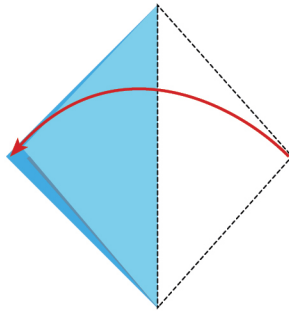


WHALE ORIGAMI

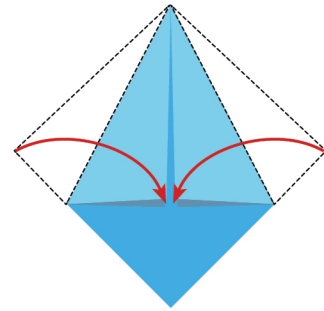
While Nick Bland drew his whales for Walk of the Whales it would be fun to have a 3D whale or a whole lot of them to create a diorama of the whales somewhere they do not belong to make people aware of this book. Use the instructions below to make an origami whale.



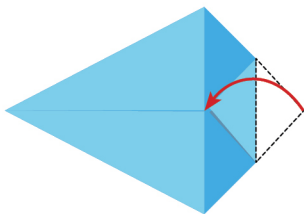
Use a square piece of paper



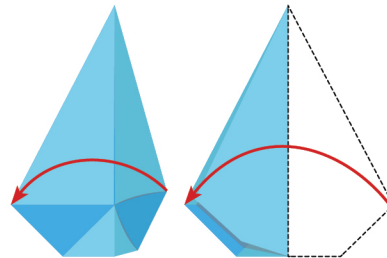
Fold it in half to create a crease in the middle - then open.



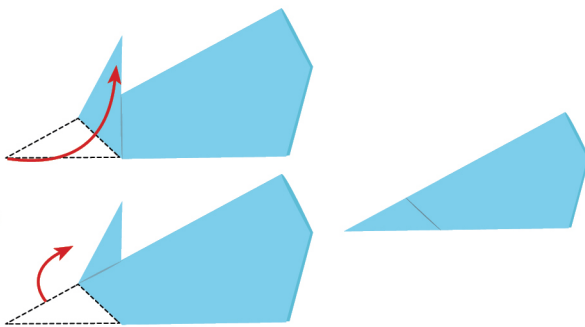
Fold both vertices from the left and the right to meet in the middle of the crease.



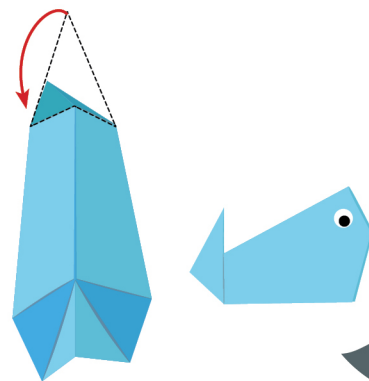
Fold the other vertex to the center until it meets the other vertices.



Fold the paper in half.



Fold the tail from both sides to create a crease then return to original position.



Open your whale. While facing the folded part, fold the tail backward while following the crease. Draw eyes on both sides to finalise your whale.
