

A MATHS 'N' MOVEMENT LANGUAGE ACTIVITY

This book provides an opportunity for children to learn some Adnyamathanha words which are woven cleverly throughout the text. Using the cards below and some of the Fundamental Movement Skills children can learn some of the words from one of Australia 350 First Nations languages.

YOU WILL NEED

The cards below printed onto cardboard and cut out

ACTIVITY

- 1 Distribute the cards between students and keep a copy of each for yourself.
- 2 Stand in the middle of the circle and read out of hold up one card.
- 3 Children with that word or image must use the given fundamental movement skill to move through the middle of the circle to swap with someone who has the same card on the other side of the circle.
- 4 The first or last student to cross the circle could be chosen to call out the next Adnyamathanha word as they slip back into the circle and a new student is chosen to be in the middle.
- 5 Swap the cards every 5 or so rounds as you repeat the process of calling a new Fundamental Movement Skills and cards and children become familiar with all the words.
