



SEED BOMBS

In Tiny Wonders the small child tries to bring back wonder with flowers. You can do this too by making flower bombs which you can use yourself or give away for others to use.

YOU WILL NEED

- Wildflower seeds - from your garden or a garden shop. It is very important that native seeds are used rather than potential weed seeds.
- Clay powder from craft shops or clay soil if available
- Peat-free compost
- Water
- A bowl

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Mix 1 cup of seeds with 5 cups of compost and 2-3 cups of clay powder or clay soil in a bowl.
- 2 Slowly mix in water with your hands until everything sticks together.
- 3 Roll the mixture into firm balls.
- 4 Leave the balls to dry in a sunny spot.
- 5 Now for the fun bit! Plant your seed bombs by throwing them at bare parts of the garden or on urban wasteland (neglected roundabouts, flower beds and planters etc) and wait to see what pops up!

Engage with situations to explore their environment and nature.
