YOU WILL NEED

- A selection of interesting small objects the number of objects is dictated by the age of the children playing.
- A tray on which to arrange the objects.
- A tea-towel or cloth large enough to cover the tray.
- A pencil and paper per player to record their answer.

HOW TO PLAY

- Uncover the tray and place it where all children can see it.
- Give the children a certain amount of time to memorize the contents of the tray, then cover it up again.

Variation 1

Ask the children to write down all of the objects that they can remember.

Variation 2

Remove one object from the tray and when uncovered again children write down the object which is missing.
