SHARK GAME

Sharks are apex predators. They clean the oceans by feeding on slower and injured sea life or those unable to adequately hide. Children can play a game similar to this with some students as sharks and others as their prey.

YOU WILL NEED

A large area without obstacles such as a hall or playground with a row of chairs placed on each side.

GAME RULES

- The sharks count to 10 while the sea creatures disperse or occupy the chairs.
- 2 Once they reach 10 they call out "feeding time" and they must try to catch the other students.
- 3 If they "tip" a student they are eaten and must sit out until the next game.
- Players can "hide" by sitting on the chairs but can only hide for a count of 20 before having to cross the "sea" to the other side.
- Once all players are tagged the sharks swap with new players and the game is played again.
