

CHALK MAKING

The children colour the concrete with chalk. Use the instructions below to make your own chalk to draw with.

YOU WILL NEED

- 2 cups - Plaster of Paris
- 1 cup water
- 1 x large disposable mixing container (empty jar or tin)
- 1 x small disposable mixing container per colour (plastic cup)
- Poster paint
- Dishwashing liquid
- Moulds - ice block trays, egg cartons or toilet rolls - sealed with masking tape at one end
- Non-stick spray or non-stick paper to line moulds if they are not non-stick

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Mix the water and Plaster of Paris in the large container.
- 2 Pour equal parts of the mixture into each smaller mixing container.
- 3 Add a couple of drops of dishwashing liquid to each cup.
- 4 Add paint to each cup to colour each chalk.
- 5 Pour the coloured mixture into the moulds.
- 6 When dry - start drawing.



Follows a sequence of steps for making designed solutions such as a recipe.
