In 1832, Caroline established the Female School of Industry for Daughters of European Soldiers.

Caroline set up the Female Immigrants House in Sydney in 1841.

At 20 Caroline met Captain Archie Chisholm.

Caroline's 21 year old son and 10 month old daughter both died.

In 1858 Caroline opened a school for girls in Newtown.

September 1938 Caroline, Archie and their two sons moved to Sydney, Australia.

Caroline returned to England in 1866 and lived in Highgate London until her death.

Caroline Jones was born on May 30, 1808.

In October 1854 Caroline visited the Victorian goldfields to set up shelters for women.

Caroline and Archie Chisholm were married in 1830.

Caroline Chisholm died on March 25, 1877 - Her gravestone says "Here lie the Emigrant's Friend".

Caroline set up a store in Kyneton near the goldfields and the shelters she has established.
