

INK AND WATERCOLOUR ART

In the back of *Pandemic*, Bruce Whatley explains that the images for the story were created during his time in isolation with no access to art supplies other than a pen and a very small selection of water colour paints. In the space below use lead pencil to lightly sketch the children delivering jugs of milk, the lambs being fed or the eggs being collected. When you are happy with your picture outline it in biro pen that won't run and then use either water colour paints or watered down classroom paint to colour the picture. It doesn't matter if the colours run slightly or spatter the background as this will just make your picture look more like the ones in the book.
