

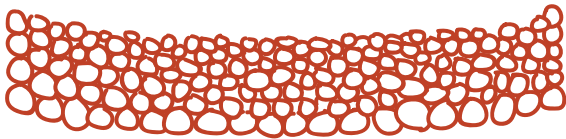

They also had long term houses built near their waterways as villages. Use the information below to draw what these houses looked like - they are nothing like bark tents.

You Will Need:

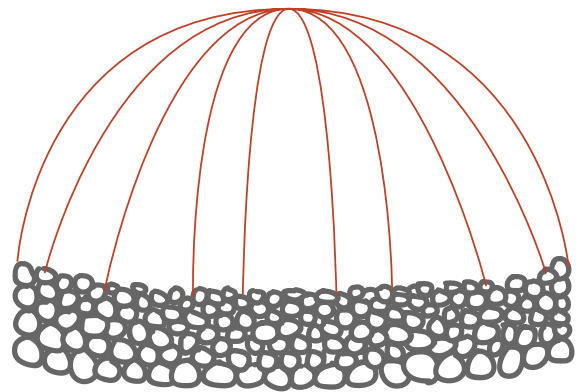
- Crayons or pencils
- Grass (This can be brown or green as it will brown over time)
- Glue

How to Make it:

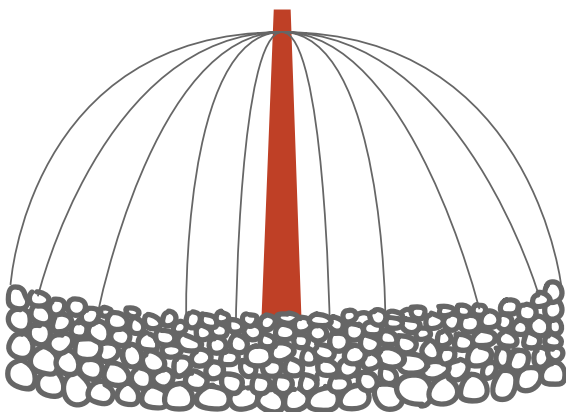
1. Draw a circle of stones at the bottom of the page. These would have been at least 1 metre tall to protect the family from the cold and the heat.
2. Draw a tall curve from 1 side of the circle to the other like a dome.
3. Repeat this around the circle.
4. Draw a large brown stick protruding from the middle of the circle.
5. Cover the curved lines with glue and paste on the grass.



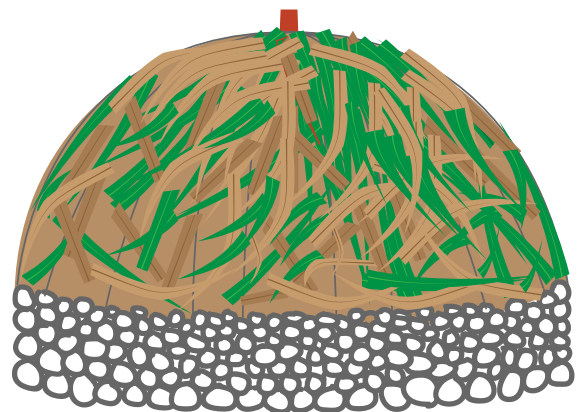
